<u>Reading</u>

- Pre-read the text before the lesson
- Explain things verbally or through other kinds of media
- Highlight key words within texts
- Add images to the text to help with understanding
- Provide a glossary
- Enlarge text or use a different coloured paper
- Use different colour font to separate sections of text

Recording of work

Mind maps, tables, diagrams, annotated sketches or simple sentences

- Photographs
- Provide a template or WAGOLL
- Verbally discuss ideas and record through ipad
- Use computers or ipads to record ideas
