Reading

- Provide visual aids to clarify instruments, dimensions of music
- Size of font for notation
- Highlighted vocabulary/terminology
- Pictorial word bank
- Read text aloud
- Provide simplified glossary
- Use of non-standard notation

Recording of work

- Photographs
- Templates and ready-made grids
- Non-standard notation
- Performance/oral responses rather than written
- Video recordings

- Ear defenders

- Scaffolds - Composing grids, notation grids
- Audacity
- Chime bars
- Picture prompts
- Partially worked examples/worked examples as a prompt.
- Instrument adaptations for physical needs.

Teaching approaches

- Provide a model for children to refer to.
- Use of visualiser.
- Demonstration, modelling, echo and response
- Consider grouping/partner work
- Break down into small steps
- Slow tempo in music
