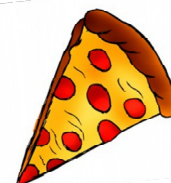
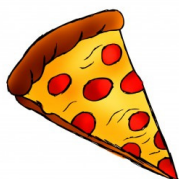

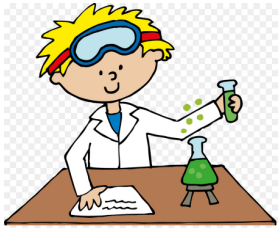


## Science Week - Parent Cafés
